BEHAVIORAL GUIDELINES

As a participating student athlete in the women's lacrosse program, I agree to abide by the following:

- Be responsible for myself and act professionally at all team activities
- Model the spirit of sportspersonship by respecting teammates, opponents, coaches, and officials
- Comply with all rules and regulations set forth by the University of Utah, the Department of Athletics and Recreation, the national governing organization, the league, and the NCAA
- Show respect for the University of Utah facilities and any other host facilities used for club activities
- Attend all team sponsored activities, practices and games.

Behaviors that may result in disciplinary actions include, but are NOT limited to:

- Written or verbal complaints regarding individual and/or team behavior
- Damage to equipment or property while on campus or during travel
- Missed attendance at required meetings, practice and games
- Failure to report incidents or failure to turn in required forms, etc.
- Any participation in hazing

ACADEMIC INTEGRITY
